Role Description

Camp Narnia is a children's summer camp centred on imagination, community and experiential education. Our team of counselors is the backbone of the staff team, looking after the camper's basic needs, running the program, and setting the tone for the whole camp experience with their attitude and actions.

Each counselor has a group of 5-7 campers who are their responsibility, and they will be with them throughout all of the activities of the week, sleep in their cabin, and be those camper's first point of contact with the staff team. Counselors are the "big brother/sister" that campers look up to as parent, role model, facilitator and problem solver during their week at camp.

Responsibilities

- Live together with the campers and facilitate the healthy and happy development of the cabin group
- Run all basic program activities
- Participate in the camp daily routine, including mealtimes, free time supervision, morning and evening routines
- Provide care for their cabin group including awareness of their food, water, medication hygiene and social relationships, addressing minor concerns and raising major concerns immediately to program staff and camp directors.
- Take full responsibility for ensuring their campers have a safe, fun, and magical experience at camp.
- Attend a full week of Staff Training from July 26th to August 1st 2020.

Personal Specification

Camp counsellors need to be able to relate to children, and enjoy spending time with them. In this role, the counselor will be in constant contact with their campers, and will need to have the patience, positive attitude and awareness of children's basic needs to help the campers with their daily challenges.

Most importantly, camp counselors must combine a mature, responsible attitude towards work with an ability to have fun, be creative, and enjoy the often wild and silly fun of our camp.

Camp counselors must have proven experience working with children and be able to present a positive image and attitude in line with the values of Camp Narnia.
